

Exchange: An ETF Experience is scheduled to take place in-person from Monday, April 11 to Thursday, April 14 at The Fontainebleau Miami. The language below aims to outline clear health and safety guidelines and precautions. Below is our plan that is intended to give sponsors, guests and staff a safe environment to work in. The Exchange ETF team considers the health and safety of all those on-site our top priority. We are committed to executing this event safely during global public-health challenges. To accomplish this goal, we need all participants, including speakers, sponsors, staff and vendors, to do their part as well. These considerations will continue to evolve and are subject to change.

All individuals at the event (guests, sponsors, speakers, staff and vendors) are required to show proof of vaccination **OR** a negative COVID test upon arrival before entering the event space.

PROOF OF VACCINATION: Guests will be required to show proof that they have received two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine* (with final dose administered at least 14 days prior to the event), with valid ID (driver's license; government-issued ID card; passport) during check-in at the event. A photo on your phone with a picture of your vaccination card will be accepted. *Vaccines accepted: Pfizer-BioNtech; Moderna; Oxford-AstraZeneca; Johnson & Johnson/Janssen.

COVID TESTS: Tests must be taken within 72 hours of arrival at the event. It is the responsibility of attendees choosing to show a negative test to get their test before they arrive at Exchange. Please take a picture of your negative test alongside your government ID with a timestamp and present this as one picture when you check in at the registration desk. PCR, antigen and at-home tests will all be accepted.

MASKS: While wearing masks at Exchange is optional, if you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, please do so. We encourage all attendees to be mindful and respectful of everyone's mask choice.

HEALTH & SAFETY: Exchange ETF values the safety of its guests, sponsors, speakers, staff, employees and vendors. Despite our best efforts, we cannot absolutely guarantee that you will not be exposed to COVID-19 while attending this event. An inherent risk of such exposure exists in any large gathering. By attending this event, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agree to abide by established protocols and guidelines.
